

SPRING BUNNY and EGGS

Materials & Notes

- ▲ Shown using Red Heart Super Saver Yarn
Medium weight yarn - (UK Aran Weight).
Pastel colours - small amounts of stash yarn.
- ▲ 5mm Crochet Hook
- ▲ Toy eyes and nose (images show 6mm eyes)
- ▲ Toy Stuffing
- ▲ Scissors
- ▲ Needles for sewing

Worked in continuous rounds except the ears.

Abbreviations

MC – make a magic circle with number of stitches shown

Sc – Single crochet

Dec – decrease 1 stitch by working 2 stitches together

Inc – increase 1 stitch by working 2 stitches into the same stitch

Foff – fasten off

Slp St – slip stitch

Ch - chain

Stitch count is shown at the end of the rounds.



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Eggs

MC6,

inc x6 (12)

(SC2, inc) x4 (16)

(SC3, Inc) x4 (20)

SC20

SC20

SC20

(SC3, dec) x4 (16)

(SC6, dec) x2 (14)

SC1, dec, SC2, dec, SC2, dec, SC1, dec (10)

*Stuff quite firmly, continue to stuff for next finishing rounds.

(SC1, dec) x3

Do one further dec (goes into the next round) – fasten off.
Thread needle and pull through remaining loops (will be approx. 6/7 loops, pull tight to finish.

▲ To do striped or coloured eggs, use the middle 3 rounds (SC20) to do any change of colours, these rounds have no increase or decrease stitches.

Feet

(make 2) – In Body Colour

MC5,

inc x 4, SC1 (9)

SC8, inc (10)

SC10

SC10

SC10

SC6, dec, SC2 (9)

SC9

Dec x 4, slp st and fasten off.



Tail

Tail – In contrast colour or white

MC7

inc x 4, SC3 (11)

SC1, dec x 5, slp st to fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

You can use a small pom pom for the tail instead.



Body

Body – starts at top of head – In body colour

MC6, inc x6 (12)
(SC2, inc) x4 (16)
(SC3, inc) x4 (20)
SC20
(SC4, inc) x4 (24)
SC24
SC24
SC24
(SC6, dec) x3 (21)
(SC5, dec) x3 (18)
SC2, dec, SC2, dec, SC3, dec, SC2, dec, SC1 (14)
Stop here to attach eyes.



* Add eyes 5 rows down (5th row from top and 2 stitches apart.)
Eye, hole, hole, eye. Image above.

*Stuff firmly and continue to stuff whilst working the last rounds.
(SC1, dec) x2, SC2 (dec, SC1) x2 (10)

Dec x 5 fasten off, thread needle and pull through remaining stitches to finish.

Ear (make 2) – Starts in contrast and changes to body colour

Chain 4, (work around chain)

Starting In 2nd chain from hook, SC2, SC3 stitches into the last stitch (3 into same st increasing 2), working round, SC2, SC2 into last stitch (2 in same stitch increasing one). (9)

SC9
SC9 changing yarn colour on last stitch
SC9 in new colour
Inc, SC4, inc, SC3 (11)
SC11
SC1, inc, SC9 (12)
SC12
SC12
SC1, dec, dec, SC2, dec, dec, SC1 (8)
Dec, SC2, dec, dec, slp st and fasten off
- Natural fold is on the colour change.



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Nose



Nose – in contrast colour

MC6,
inc x 3, SC1 pull through fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Thread the tail end and take the needle down into next stitch and pull through. This is optional but does give a neat finish.

Use this tail end to attach the nose to the body in the finishing steps.

- ▲ Attach the toy nose in the centre hole and do any embroidery. Continue to assembly and finishing.

Assembly & Finishing

- ▲ Using the images as a guide, sew the feet, nose and ears to the body.
 - ▲ Position the feet on the bottom to help it sit (image shown in the feet instructions, left) The tail can be used for extra balance to help sit.
 - ▲ The nose is sewn on just below the eyes..
 - ▲ The ears have a natural fold which is on the colour change. Attach to the sides of the body near to the top of the head, make sure they are not too low when sat.
- Enjoy your bunny make.



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
